Syed Ali Raza, President NBP and Dr. Zulfiqar Ali Mirza Home Minister Sindh, Visited Third Medical Relief Camp Organized by NBP For Flood Affected People at Government School Gizri, Karachi

September 29, 2010: NBP organized its third medical relief camp for flood affected people at Government School Gizri, Karachi after successful arrangements of Medical Relief Camps at Razzakabad and Pipri, Karachi. Specialists and consultant doctors of skin, gynea, eye, neuro and other specialists attended the patients. The flood affectees were given free consultation by doctors and free treatment and free medicines were distributed.

The camp was visited by Syed Ali Raza, President NBP, Dr. Zulfiqar Ali Mirza, Home Minister Sindh, Mr. Shahab Kazi, Head of Media Marketing & PR and from People's Doctors Forum, Dr. Kareem Khawaja and other volunteers of NBP and Peoples Doctors Forum visited the camp and praised the efforts for organizing medical camps and announced that with the help of People's Doctors Forum, NBP will arrange and organize these type of medical camps in other affected areas of Pakistan as well.

NBP also distributed food packets costing approximately Rs.1,500/- per packet in the flood affected people at the camp. Each bag contained eatables for a family of about six persons and will suffice their eating requirements for approximately one week.

NBP has distributed more than 40,000 bags of eatables in the affected families.
